

Jan 17 the Kananaskis Village area trails were refreshed after a few cms of light snow fell. Conditions are good to fair for the area with trackset now in most places. There are still many thin spots to be found, especially on Kovach south below Aspen junction. Downhill travel is not recommended here. There is a big ice flow at Link / Ribbon jct that extends half way down the hill making travel difficult.

Jan 16 the upper Skogan Pass area trails were groomed and trackset today. Lower Skogan is still extremely thin and not recommended for downhill travel.

Skogan Loop is thin on the south facing hill , beautiful snow on the backside.

The trails out of Ribbon Creek parking are still very thin and require for less snow. While they are skiable skiing is
